The HIDTA program is overseen by the Office of National Drug Control Policy, a directive of the Executive Office of the President of the United States. North Central HIDTA is a federal program designed to encourage and support federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies to work together in multi-agency task forces in order to reduce specific drug threats in the HIDTA designated region. North Central HIDTA is a national standard for collectively sharing information and partnering, which targets and dismantles the most significant Drug Trafficking Organizations (DTOs) and Money Laundering Organizations (MLOs) posing the greatest threat to the community.





Case Highlight

The Washington County Drug Task Force collaborated with the Dakota County Drug Task Force, Ramsey County Drug Task Force, United States Postal Inspection Service (USPIS) and several other agencies to investigate and identify M-30

fentanyl dealers in the area. The investigation led to the seizure of 280,000 fentanyl pills by USPIS, and an additional 77,000 fentanyl pills seized by the Washington County Drug Task Force. As a result, the large DTO responsible for distributing M-30 fentanyl pills was dismantled and nine federal indictments were issued.

Case Highlight

The Dane County Drug Task Force worked with the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation and the United States Postal Inspection Service to dismantle a fentanyl DTO. The investigators discovered that the DTO

was primarily using the U.S. Mail to distribute kilogram quantities of fentanyl tablets. Investigators were then able to initiate wire intercepts on the phones of the main conspirators based in Wisconsin, which helped identify the source of supply and additional distribution cells. The investigation concluded with eight federal indictments and the seizure of approximately four kilograms of fentanyl tablets.


