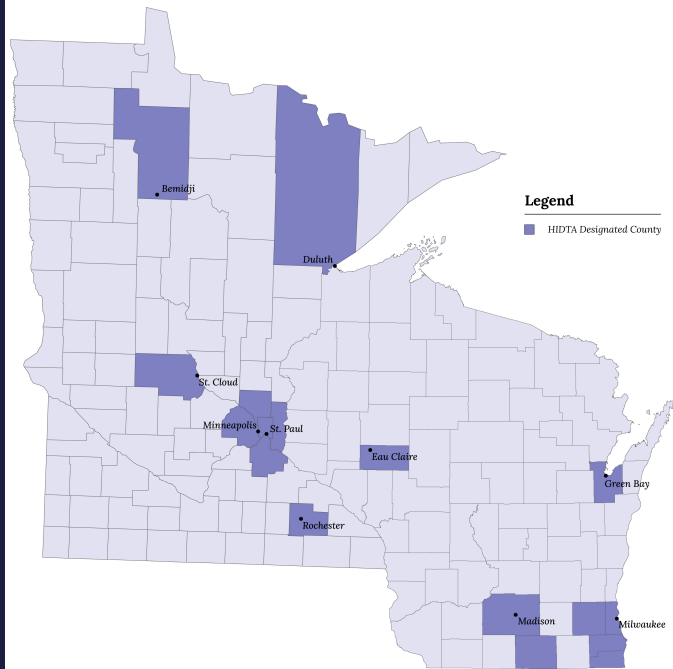

Mission Statement

North Central HIDTA is a federal program designed to encourage and support federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies to work together in multi-agency task forces in order to reduce specific drug threats in the HIDTA designated region. North Central HIDTA is a national standard for collectively sharing information and partnering, which targets and dismantles the most significant Drug Trafficking Organizations (DTOs) and Money Laundering Organizations (MLOs) posing the greatest threat to the community.
